Sri NAVCHANDI PAARAYAN and NAVA CHANDI YAGNA will be performed at the Hindu Temple of Ottawa-Carleton on Friday September 30th and Saturday October 1st during Durga Navarati.

Sri Devi Mahatmyam, also called Durga Saptashati, consists of 700 slokas in the Markandeya Purana. *They describe the Divine mahima of Maata Durga, Maha Lakshmi and Maha Saraswathi* which are all manifestations of the *maha shakthi - the Absolute Universal Energy !* These auspicious ceremonies are performed during Durga navratri to seek Durga maata's blessings for health, prosperity, happiness and long-life for the family and for viswa shanthi.

Sri NavChandi Paarayan or Chandi Path is the recitation of Devi Mahatmyam. Paarayan will take place in the evening of Friday September 30<sup>th</sup>.
